"Design and layout was done through our in-house editorial and prepress departments. It was stitched and printed on a MAN Roland Geoman double-width high-speed web offset newspaper press and trimmed on a Ferag SNT480 trimming drum.

"The print quality, web alignment, registration and print finishing achieved for this job was exceptional."
